Jesse revitalized the garden by removing the current plant beds, renewing the soil, planting native shrubs, and installing soaker and garden hoses for easier care. He replaced the wood chips ground cover with new chips, installed a new cloth weed block and removed and replaced the old wood fence with

a new one. Materials and plants in the garden were generously donated by several local gardens and businesses. Kathy Van Gorder of Secret Gardens contributed valuable consulting time and plants including a shadbush tree, highbush blueberries, bayberry bushes, sweet pepperbushes, spicebushes, a buttonbush, and an elderberry bush. Other businesses include: McEachern and Hutchins. Hammond Lumber, Frost Farms, K.M. Harper, Paradis Ace Hardware, Salsbury Organics, and Secret Gardens.




Downeast:

Southwest Harbor Public Library sailed through its 126th year – still going strong. Buffeted by the changing winds of the pandemic across the months, the Staff and Board adapted to stay on course to provide the high level of service and the quality of the print and digital collections that we

have all come to expect. We can't do it without all our community friends and supporters. We thank you all so very much.

The Library had record level of responses to the Annual Appeal, exceeding our budget by over \$25,000 and garnering support from almost 100 new donors. The continuing investment in this stellar public library, at the heart of our community, encourages and sustains the staff, the board and all our volunteers.

Our Annual Giant Book Sale receipts also exceeded our 2021 goal by over \$4,000. The many volunteers and the help from the **U. S. Coast Guard** were key to this accomplishment last summer. Books flew off the shelves of the Main Street kiosk all year long; it has become a landmark for sure. The August Silent Art Auction celebrated the creative genius of our community artists, in an impressive variety of artwork. Thanks to the support of community partners, such as the SWH Medical Center and the Hattie A. & Fred C. Lynam Trust. SWHPL Summer Story Camp strengthened the literacy skills of our young readers, while at the same time inspired them by the variety of stories they read and the journeys the books took them on through time and imagination. We are so proud of this successful program, building a love of life-long learning at an early age.

Your support makes possible the **cloudLibrary**, the vast array of movies in **Kanopy**, and the rich resources of our **Digital Archive**. Please check these services out if you are not yet using them. Our year-long calendar of programs and speakers is another valuable outreach from your library. If you want to get more deeply involved in the programs and activities of your Library, please don't hesitate to reach out to a member of the staff or the Library Board. On to 2022, and another "five-star year"!




Treasurer's Report




